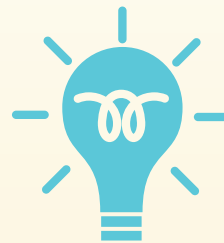

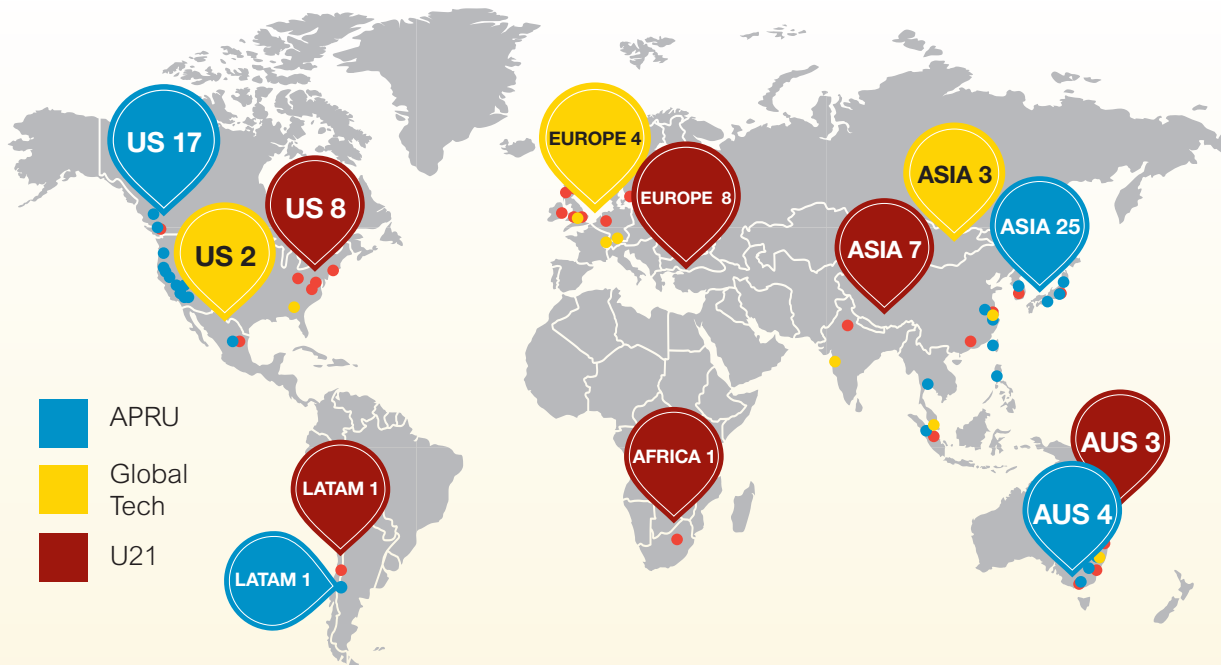

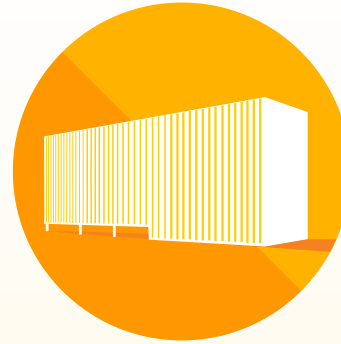


CULTIVATING YOUR ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT

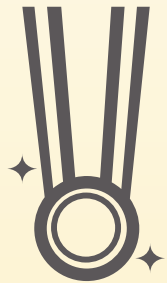

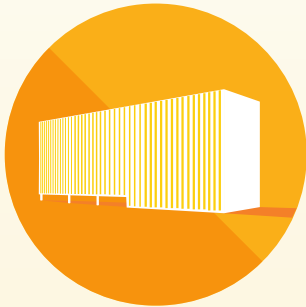
